SU Press book *Disability Rhetoric* wins prestigious PROSE award

Syracuse University Press title *Disability Rhetoric* by Jay Timothy Dolmage won a 2015 PROSE Award in the Language and Linguistics category. Dolmage is associate professor of English at the University of Waterloo and founding editor of the *Canadian Journal of Disability Studies*.

Since 1976, the American Publishers Awards for Professional and Scholarly Excellence annually recognize the best in professional and scholarly publishing by bringing attention to distinguished books, journals, and electronic content in over 40 categories. Judged by peer publishers, librarians, and medical professionals, the awards recognize publishers and authors for their commitment to pioneering works of research and for contributing to the conception, production, and design of landmark works in their fields.
