launch the “Bird Plug-In” project**

The Student Philanthropy Council and Syracuse University Libraries have joined forces to launch the [“Bird Library Plug-In” project](#) on ‘CuseFunder—*crowdfunding for great SU causes*. The project will address the #1 student complaint about Bird Library—the need for more power outlets.
